Eastleigh Lakes Location



Lakeside Country Park, Wide Lane, Eastleigh SO50 5PE.

From J5 M27 towards Eastleigh A335 (Wide Lane) for ½ mile.

The park entrance is signed on the left just past the playing fields.

Follow the postcode SO50 6HN and turn off the B3335 Highbridge Road at the concreted entrance to Highbridge Farm south west of the Itchen river bridge then follow the track as shown to our Cabin and Pond (which is now larger than seen on Google Earth)

Our Club

If you are interested in Model Boating, be it Scale models or RC Sailing, we are one of the friendliest clubs in the South to welcome all skill levels from beginners to experienced builders, including supervised juniors.

Sail:- The Club has an active radio yacht racing division, which hires one of the lakes in Eastleigh Lakeside Country Park, on three mornings a week; Wednesday, Friday and Sundays. We race International One Metres, Radio Marbleheads and Dragon Force 65s. The details may be found on the Sail Division website, <https://radiosaileastleigh.com/>

Scale:- We cater for all types of model ships and boats. Whether they are scratch built, kits, ARTF, collectables, made from any materials, scale, semi or non scale. Powered by electric, steam or sail (but our facilities are not suitable for I.C. engine powered models).

Facilities:- Sail at Lakeside, Scale at Highbridge Farm.

At **Lakeside** we are officially authorised by Eastleigh Borough Council to use one of the Lakeside lakes. The Council usually permits us to take cars to the water side, and to keep our race marks on the lake, throughout the year. There are bathroom facilities in the Park, and a cafe at the nearby model railway.

At **Highbridge** the club has its own exclusive boating lake within the grounds of Highbridge Farm with a clubhouse, jetty and free adjacent parking. We meet here every Sunday and Wednesday at 10.00am to sail or work to further improve our facilities.

Social Events:- A full diary of events is organised throughout the year including visits to other clubs and attendance at shows/exhibitions both local and national together with social activities.

Insurance:- Membership brings 'Public Liability' insurance cover for yachting and other model sailing activities nationwide the details of which are available on request.
